CLASSES:

Class 1

INTERMEDIATE TEAM CHASE – (SPEED)

Entry fee: £180

Prizes: 1st £200, 2nd £130, 3rd £100 Rosettes to 10th place

Fixed height fences will be no more than 3'9" and the course will be approx. two miles. Teams may be of three or four horses. The time of the third horse over the finish will be the time for the team. The team finishing with the fastest time wins. Horses must be 14.2 hh or over and must be 5 years old or over. Riders must have attained their 16th birthday.

Special Prize: The Derek Sidebottom Cup will be presented to the highest placed Beaufort Hunt team

Class 2

INTERMEDIATE TEAM CHASE – (BOGEY)

Entry fee: £160

Prizes: 1st £180, 2nd £110, 3rd £90 Rosettes to 10th place

Fixed height fences will be no more than 3'9" and the course will be approx. two miles. Teams may be of three or four horses. The time of the third horse over the finish will be the time for the team. The team finishing in a time nearest the bogey time, judged to be a fair hunting pace will be the winner. Horses must be 14.2 hh or over and must be 5 years old or over. Riders must have attained their 14th birthday.

Special Prize: The Cup will be presented to the highest placed Beaufort Hunt

Class 3

NOVICE TEAM CHASE (SPEED)

Entry fee: £150

Prizes: 1st £160, 2nd £120, 3rd £75 Rosettes to 10th place

Fixed height fences will be no more than 3'3" and the course will be approx. one and a half miles. Teams may be of three or four horses/ponies. The time of the third horse/pony over the finish will be the time for the team. The team finishing in a time nearest to the bogey time, judged at a fair hunting pace, will be the winner. Horses/ponies must be 13.2 hh or over and must be 5 years old or over. Riders must be in their 12th year.

Special Prize:

Class 4

Entry fee: £140

Prizes in kind & Rosettes to 10th place

Fixed height fences will be no more than 3'3" and the course will be approx. one and a half miles. Teams may be of three or four horses/ponies. The time of the third horse/pony over the finish will be the time for the team. The team finishing in a time nearest to the bogey time, judged at a fair hunting pace, will be the winner. Horses/ponies must be 13.2 hh or over and must be 5 years old or over. Riders must be in their 12th year.

All cars, horseboxes and trailers are parked at owners risk in the designated areas.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT: The Organiser reserves the right to

1. Cancel or divide any class
2. Withhold any prizes because of insufficient declared entries
3. Eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules
4. Transfer competitors between sections of a class
5. Alter the advertised times
6. Refuse any entry
7. Split the prize money in the event of a tie

HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT: The Organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of every person present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser, officials and stewards. The Organiser advises that, due to uneven and, in parts, irregular terrain at this event, it may be difficult at times for spectators to move around freely and easily, as a result of which it may not be suitable for these spectators who suffer from certain medical conditions. All the spectators enter the event at their own risk and are advised to wear suitable footwear. The Organiser shall not incur any liability, except as required by law, in respect of any injury or damage to any spectators howsoever sustained.

No motorised vehicles including ATVs are permitted on the course other than officials. Permitted visitors with mobility restrictions should contact the secretary before the event for assistance. Please see Selina's details above.

In all classes competitors must wear an approved crash helmet. Only the following hat standards are accepted: British and European PAS 015 (2011) or VG01 040 2014-12 – both with a BSI Kitemark or Inspect IC Mark; American ASTM F1163 2004a onwards with SEI mark, Snell 2016 or 2021 (no other mark is needed with Snell) or Australia and New Zealand AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards with SAI Global mark. All competitors must also wear a British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA 2018) approved and appropriately labelled Level 3 (purple label) body protector.

ALL HATS MUST BE TAGGED WITH THE LATEST TAG IN ACCORDANCE WITH BE/PC/BTC.

HATS AND BACK PROTECTORS WILL BE RANDOMLY CHECKED IN THE COLLECTING RING AND IF NOT TAGGED COMPETITORS WILL BE UNABLE TO START. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK YOUR EQUIPMENT (HATS AND BACK PROTECTORS) IS UP TO THE CORRECT AND REQUIRED STANDARD

GENERAL RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. BHSA (2023) TEAM CHASE RULES APPLY for ALL Classes. These may be viewed on www.britishteamchasing.co.uk and on the Information board on the day. Some of these rules are mentioned below, along with the Beaufort Hunt Supporters Team Chase Rules.
2. HORSES may not compete twice in a class, other than if Rule 8g applies. Horses may **not run in two** Team Chase Speed Classes.
3. For TEAM CHASE CLASSES each TEAM is to consist of a maximum of FOUR HORSES AND RIDERS and at least three must complete the course to finish. Team members are started together. First horse starts the clock and the time of the third horse to finish, will be the finishing time for the team. In the event of a tie the fourth horse to finish will decide.
4. In BOGEY classes, the closer to the Optimum Time (OT), the less time faults incurred wins. The OT is calculated from the speed declared, over the course for each Class. A slower time away from the OT will be placed higher than a faster time if they are both the same distance away from the OT.
5. COURSE LENGTHS and NUMBER OF FENCES, stated in the schedule, are approximate. FENCE HEIGHTS refer to the maximum height of fixed rails. Hedges may be higher.
6. In ALL CLASSES competitors must JUMP every fence on their course only, in order, and pass between all designated flags. Jumping the wrong fence (flagged or un flagged will result in elimination of that horse and rider)
7. PENALTIES will be scored as follows: REFUSALS will not be penalised, but a competitor who has more than three refusals at any one fence, or five in total, will be eliminated and must leave the course. The team will be disqualified for abuse of this rule by any individual member. The first 12 hooves must be within the PEN at one time or a 20 second time PENALTY will be awarded.

8. When ANY RIDER or HORSE FALLS during any class, they are immediately eliminated and may not continue on the course. A horse fall is when, at the same time its shoulder and quarters have touched either the ground or the obstacle and the ground, or when it is trapped in a fence in such a way that it is unable to proceed without assistance or is liable to injure itself. This does not prevent horses which stumble or refuse.

9. Any horse ELIMINATED or RETIRING must leave the course at a walk.

10. After a RIDER FALL the rider, on NO ACCOUNT may REMOUNT and must be seen by the events medical team. If they do remount the team will be eliminated.

11. Each Team will be given a STARTING TIME. Any team missing its correct time may be fitted in at the end of the Class, if possible but this is not guaranteed.

12. Team Captains must declare their teams at least 60 minutes prior to their appointed starting time and register any change of horse or rider. Each Team / Competitor must report to the COLLECTING RING Steward 15 minutes before his or her actual starting time.

13. NUMBERS Team Captains are responsible for number bids. CASH DEPOSIT of £20 at the secretary. Competitors are asked to ride in the correct colour and to notify the Secretary of any team changes.

14. Competitors may exercise their horses beforehand only in the warm up area provided, which includes a PRACTICE jump.

15. All competitors must wear HEADGEAR and a BACK PROTECTOR to current British Safety Standards (see BTC rule 7.) Team Chase competitors must report to the information point, with their helmets if they have not previously received a Hat Tag. Anyone mounted must wear a safety helmet. Hunting, cross country or team dress to be worn.

16. The ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHTS to: Withhold or amend any prize or cancel any class because of insufficient entries; Alter the advertised times; Refuse any entry with or without stating reasons; Alter the course or leave out any obstacle before or during the competition; Split a class if there is a significant change in course; Eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules; Eliminate any horse they consider to be exhausted; Eliminate any competitor for excessive use of the whip or inappropriate language. In the event of a dispute, the chief steward's decision is final. Any team captain wishing to lodge an objection must first lodge £40 CASH with the event secretary and make their objection in writing. If upheld the deposit will be refunded.

17. No refund of entry fees will be made if the event is POSTPONED due to bad weather or any other unforeseen circumstances (such as Covid); team chase entry fees will be carried forward to the next date available for the event in the same calendar year, less an admin charge. In the event of cancellation 75% of entry monies to be refunded if the cancellation occurs prior to the close of entries, 50% of entry monies to be refunded if the event is cancelled after the close of entries and up until 48 hours before the event and 25% of entry monies to be refunded if the event is cancelled 48 hours or less prior to the event.

18. It is a requirement that all participants carry third party insurance for not less than £5m. It is also strongly recommended that all participants have personal accident insurance.
